God gives these men special graces and powers to serve him and others.</p>
<p>In the Anointing of the Sick, the priest anoints the sick person with blessed oil and lays his hands on them for strength, healing, peace and courage. This Sacrament also forgives sins if the person is not well enough to go to Confession.</p>	<p>The sacrament of Matrimony unites a man and a woman together as husband and wife. It gives them a special grace to live for Jesus and fulfill the duties and dignity of marriage.</p>
<p>The Holy Eucharist is the Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. When we receive Holy Communion we are united with Jesus and we grow in love for God and others.</p>
