





<p><b>THE PREFACE</b></p>  <p>This is a prayer of thanks giving to God for giving us salvation. It ends with the praise acclamation to God by all the people. Holy, Holy, Holy Lord.</p>	<p><b>CONSECRATION OF THE BREAD</b></p> <p>The Priest does as Jesus did at the Last Supper, saying take this, all of you, and eat it: This is my Body</p> 	<p><b>CONSECRATION OF THE WINE</b></p> <p>The Priest change the wine into the living Blood of Jesus, uses the same words as Jesus uses at the Last Supper</p>  <p>Take this, all of you and drink for it: This is the cup of my Blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant, it will be shed for you and for all men so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of.</p>
<p><b>THE GREAT AMEN</b></p> <p>We give our assent to all that has taken place at the end of the Eucharistic prayer</p> 	<p><b>THE LORD'S PRAYER PRAYER</b></p> <p>We speak to God our Father in the words of Jesus taught us.</p>  <p><b>SIGN OF PEACE</b> <b>LAMB OF GOD</b></p>	<p><b>HOLY COMMUNION</b></p> <p>The Priest gives communion to the people</p>  <p><b>CONCLUDING RITE</b></p> <p>We receive God's blessing from the Priest: May almighty God bless you, the Father, and the son and the Holy Spirit. We answer. Amen</p>
