

Tongue of Flame Instructions

1. Print the template.
2. Cut out all the pieces.
3. Use the flame pieces as templates to trace them onto red, yellow, and orange construction paper.
4. Cut out the flame pieces and glue the pieces together.
5. Grab the rectangle templates and trace the larger pieces onto the color of your choice and the smaller piece onto red construction paper. You will need three of each.
6. Glue the smaller pieces to the larger pieces. Then glue the assembled parts together, creating one long band.
7. Glue the flame to the center of the band.
8. Choose a gift of the Holy Spirit you are looking forward to receiving within the Sacrament of Confirmation and write it on the inside of the band (e.g., courage)
9. Then write how this gift will help you lead others on the outer band (e.g., “It will help me stand up for others”).
10. Wrap the band around your head. Once you have the desired length, use a couple of paper clips or a piece of tape to hold the shape. Then add glue to set it in place.
11. Place the “tongue of flame” on your head and begin moving around the room. Find a partner and read the hint on the outer end of the band. Try to guess what gift of the Holy Spirit your partner has chosen.
