10. **Preferential Option for the Poor** – An obligation, on the part of those who would call themselves Christian, first and foremost to care for the poor and vulnerable.
11. **Call to Family, Community, and Participation** – The right and a duty to participate in family and community, seeking together the common good and well-being of all.
12. **Solidarity** – Union of one's heart and mind with those who are poor or powerless or who face injustice.
